Where the customer has purchased a product and it breaks, is defective or does not work properly for the intended purpose, the customer must notify the supplier from whom the customer bought the product ("the supplier") thereof within the warranty period. Any claim in terms of this warranty must be supported by a proof of purchase. If proof of purchase is not available, then repair, and/or service charges may be payable by the customer to the supplier.
- The faulty product must be taken to the supplier's service centre to exercise the warranty.
- 3. The supplier will refund, repair or exchange the product in terms of this warranty subject to legislative requirements. 
PURPOSE AND INTENDED USE

The Hot Tray described in this operating manual is suitable for household use to heat food and keep food warm. Using the Hot Tray for anything other than its intended use may void the warranty.

This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as:

- Staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments:
- Farm houses;
- By clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments:
- Bed and breakfast type environments.

DESCRIPTION OF PARTS



- B Normal-temperature glass surface
- C Cool-blue LED indicator light
- D Soft-touch temperature control knob
- E Insulated thermo-plastic handles
- F Non-slip rubber feet

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Designed to keep food hot and in perfect condition for hours.
- 2. Meals can be prepared and cooked when convenient and served many hours later when friends and family are ready to



- 3. Food is maintained at a heat level just below cooking temperature to prevent overcooking and drying out - the two main causes for food losing its flavour.
- 4. The double hot spots are about 20°C hotter than the rest of the Hot Tray surface - perfect for coffee, soups etc.



- 5. The temperature regulator ensures that the Hot Tray can be kept at an optimal temperature.
- 6. For best results, use shallow, flat bottomed, covered dishes.
- 7. Meat should be slightly underdone if it is to be kept on the Hot Tray for longer than 15 minutes.
- 8. Cover food with foil to prevent it from drying out.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Turn the temperature control knob clockwise to the desired position. The indicator light will come on.



- 2. To increase the temperature, turn the control knob clockwise. To decrease the temperature, turn the control knob anti-clockwise. The indicator light may switch off initially until the glass has cooled to the desired temperature.
- 3. The indicator light will switch off as soon as the desired temperature is reached and will come on again as soon as the temperature has dropped by a preset amount. This will continue as the temperature regulator maintains a constant temperature.
- 4. A higher temperature setting may be required if the appliance is used outdoors or in an area where it is exposed to a breeze.

CLEANING


- 1. Unplug the appliance before cleaning.
- 2. Let the appliance cool down.
- 3. Use a damp sponge and mild soap to clean the glass surface.



- 4. Avoid seepage of soap between the glass and frame.
- 5. Do not use abrasive or sharp objects to remove marks, as this will scratch the glass.

STORAGE

1. Remove the plug from the mains socket.



- 2. Store in a dry area.
- 3. Don't store away when hot.

SERVICE


Note: There are no user serviceable parts in this product. Never attempt to open any part or dismantle the controls.

Hints before returning the appliance:

1. Is your household socket working properly?



2. Are all required switches in the on position?



3. Ensure that the 3-pin plug is firmly in the socket and that the socket is switched on.



NOTE: If the cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent in order to avoid a hazard.
